The Gletscherbahnen Kaprun AG operates the ski and adventure resort Kitzsteinhorn – Maiskogel as well as the beginners' ski area Lechnerberg in the Kaprun town center in the Zell am See-Kaprun region in the state of Salzburg. In winter, nine cable cars, six chairlifts and nine drag lifts open up 62.5 kilometers of slopes. The company also runs nine restaurants and numerous year-round attractions.
